Pharmacist Oath

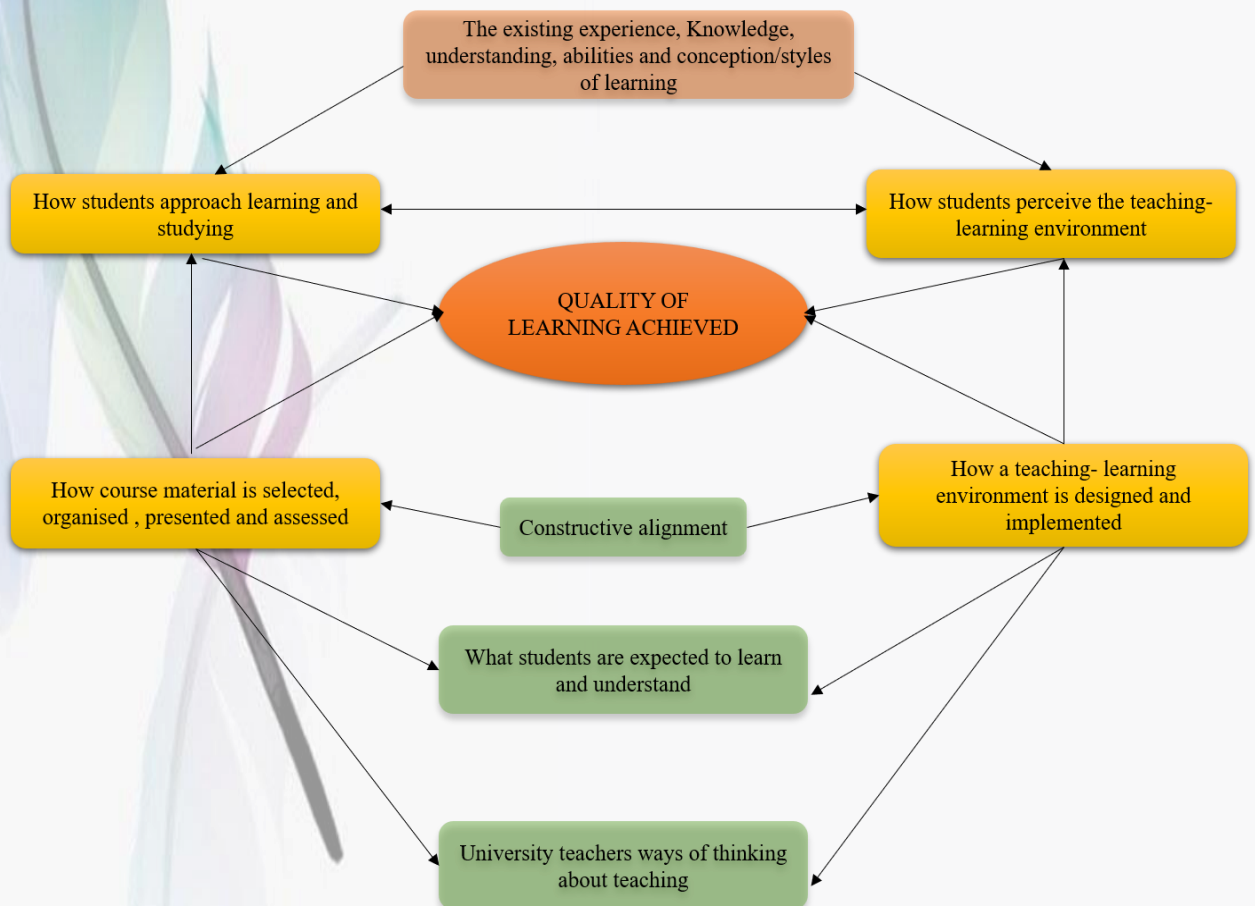
- I swear by the code of ethics of Pharmacy Council of India in relation to the community and shall act as an integral part of health care team.

Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam

He expressed that education is an endless journey through knowledge and enlightenment. Focus of the education and schools must provide mission oriented learning with value system.

Prafulla Chandra Ray

Known as the "Father of Indian Chemistry", Prafulla Chandra Ray was a prominent Bengali chemist, educator, historian, entrepreneur and philanthropist.

India's first pharmaceutical company, Bengal Chemical and Pharmaceutical Works Ltd, was established by him in 1901.

As a result of his research on nitrite, hyponitrite, and their compounds, he discovered mercurous nitrite in 1896.

His most notable work was A History of Hindu Chemistry from the Earliest Times to the Middle of the Sixteenth Century (1902). It gave an overview of ancient Indian knowledge of metallurgy and medicine.

In 1920, he was elected as president of the Indian Science Congress. In many international seminars and congresses, he represented Indian universities.

Venkatraman Ramakrishnan

Seeing that both of his parents were scientists inspired him to pursue a career in science. "Visiting scientists from India and abroad filled my childhood, and began to realize that science was a global endeavor" He became an Indian-born British and American structural biologist.

In 2009 he received the Nobel Prize in Chemistry along with Thomas A. Steitz and Ada Yonath for their studies of the structure and function of ribosomes".

Padma Vibhushan, the second highest civilian honor in India, was bestowed upon him in 2010
